Our student technicians were able to climb in, look under the hood, explore, tinker, and ask questions of the Guard mechanics. They made connections and learned of career opportunities available to them through the Guard.

EPHS CTC Automotive Instructor, Mr. David Mello, a former RI National Guard recruiter himself, was instrumental in coordinating this demonstration for the students.

Given the positive experience had by all involved, Sgt. Bickings is working with the Culinary Program to bring a Mobile Kitchen Trailer for Student-Chefs to explore, and with the Physical Education Department to bring a rock climbing wall and other physical training equipment for their students to use. Hopefully these demonstrations will take place in the next few weeks.
